Fresno County Community Development Housing Assistance Rehabilitation Program (HARP)

Fresno County Community Development has developed a housing rehabilitation program that enables eligible homeowners in participating communities to improve the quality of their housing and create a positive effect in the surrounding neighborhood.

What Can We Do?

We assist homeowners by improving energy efficiency, correcting health and safety hazards as well as code violations, making accessibility improvements and other repairs. Eligible improvements include:

- Accessibility modifications
- Replacing windows and doors
- Repairing or replacing leaking roofs
- Repairing defective plumbing
- Installing smoke detectors
- Installing new steps
- Weather stripping
- Replacement of water heaters and heating and air conditioning units
- Electrical repairs
- New gutters and downspouts
- Attic insulation, caulking
- Foundation repairs

If you require accessibility modification, we can assist by installing accessibility ramps, grab bars and other barrier-free improvements that will make it easier to get around in your home.

All work required in your home is completed by an approved, licensed contractor. Staff from Community Development will monitor the work to ensure that it is done correctly and within the program guidelines.

How Do I Qualify?

To qualify, you must be an owner-occupant of a home located in unincorporated Fresno County or the cities of Coalinga, Fowler, Kerman, Kingsburg, Mendota, Reedley, Sanger and Selma. Your property taxes and mortgage payments must be current and your household income must be within prescribed limits, based upon your family size and equity of your home. Varied loan terms are available including no interest loans, deferred payment loans depending on your income and individual needs.
