

**FENCE ENCROACHMENT**

This permit has been issued pursuant to ordinance No. 94-09 of the City of Kerman. It has authorized you to build a fence that interferes with and/or encroaches on public property or easements. Therefore this permit is issued on the following conditions:

- (1) That the city council of the City of Kerman may determine by resolution that the public need or convenience require the termination of said interference and/or encroachment, in which event on written demand by the City, said fence will be moved or modified by you or your successors in a manner that will cause said interference and/or encroachment to cease. Failure to comply with any such written demand within fifteen (15) days of the mailing thereof to the owner of the property on which said fence is appurtenant as said owner's name and address appear on the last equalized assessment roll shall constitute said fence a public nuisance subject to the abatement and assessment procedures authorized by the Government Code of the State of California relating to cities.
  
- (2) That by the execution and acceptance of this permit, the applicant agrees and expressly assumes full responsibility for and covenants to indemnify City, it's agencies, departments and subsidiaries (hereafter, collectively, the "City") against any and all claims, demands, loss, liabilities or damages that may result from injury to any person or persons or to adjoining property by reason of the excavation for, or erection, construction, or maintenance of the previously mentioned fence.

Applicant expressly undertakes to indemnify City from all liability, claims, demands, damages judgements or costs for or rising from the issuance of this permit and the actions contemplated in connection therewith, whether it be caused by the negligence of City, City's agents, employees or otherwise.
